


When you see the heart of God, what is it?









A small rural town of about 30 families, 4 kilometers off the main road.

The children often do not know when their next meal is, so we serve a full meal each day, along with tutoring, computer, and sports classes. Started in 2010, 15 children came to Christ, and many are helping the 30 younger kids who are currently in the program.



The church was started through the Living Stones program: reaching out to the children, then inviting their families to a service.








Guadalajara is a poor suburb of Paudalho (pop. 30,000), located near the main road, close to the capital of the state, Recife. Just this year, we have had over 10 children give their lives to Jesus after hearing the gospel at the program. A sports ministry since 2012, they partner with Living Stones to provide education and recreation for over 60 children.




Living Stones often partners with Glory Sports, as the children come for sports, but stay for education, character training, and nutrition (as needed).









Pop. 35,000, Lagoa is surrounded by sugarcane and is known for it's gangs and high violence. The schools are overcrowded, and there is a desperate need for a safe place for the kids to be educated.

Serving over 60 children in a full tutoring program, we have 6 teachers and also have community outreaches connecting with 150 children.



Living Stones began as the church saw the great needs around them, and wanted to make a difference in their community.








