Josefa didn't know when her birthday was because her mother couldn't read










Eduardo

11 years old








Furlough is when missionaries go back to their first home for awhile








Gustavo lives in a dirt house with a dirt floor and no bathroom

Kaylane wants a safe place to play, away from the gangs who run her city












Rachel went on a short term mission trip and later came back to be a missionary
