## Advent \& Christmastide Devotional

Advent is traditionally the four Sundays before Christmas (lighting a candle for each week, representing hope, peace, love, and joy- and then a white candle for Christmas day). Typical Advent calendars start December 1st to make it easier to reuse/commercialize. For my devotional, we will do four weeks, starting November 28 to give extra room.
The general idea is that Advent is getting ready and leading us up to Christmas. I've included devotions until January 6th which is Epiphany (in Brazil we called it Kings day), remembering the wise men. This is called Christmastide, and is the 12 days of Christmas (as I knew from the song). I could think of no better way to "wait for Christ in Christmas" than looking back at the prophesies in the Old Testament about Christ. Can you imagine living in the time before Christ? All you had was the prophesies as promises. Included is the fulfillment of each prophesy as well

## Prophecy:

"And the Lord said to me, 'Throw it to the potter'- the handsome price at which they valued me! So I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw them to the potter at the house of the Lord" (Zechariah 11:12-13).
